## Barolo Night 4 - the tasting notes

### BAROLO 2012

Here are the notes that Julia and I managed to take on the 49 Barolo 2012s and eight sparkling Nebbiolos that were served at our fourth Barolo Night at Caravan King's Cross on the Sunday evening before last. See also our photo report of this great evening, which includes some feedback and a note of the three favourite wines according to the attendees at this night and its equivalent in New York last month.

As arranged in our three identical lines of bottles on the night, to which attendees could help themselves, the wines are grouped by commune, and are listed in the order tasted, roughly in ascending level of tannin and intensity, with the sparkling wines as aperitivi before the Baroli. You can use the menu to change the order within the groups.

#### Mauro Veglio, Castelletto 2012 Barolo

16.5++

Much deeper and darker than most, with a garnet core and soft rim. Lots of baking spice here – cinnamon and nutmeg and a lovely spicy sweetness, plus something slightly floral. Complex. Malty chocolate texture on the mid palate. For now, a bit abrupt on the finish with a wall of fine tannin. (JH) 14.5%
